Members' Responsibilities*

I. GENERAL

- A. Members are expected to be civil, courteous, and considerate of others at all times.
- B. Members are reminded they represent Slopes & Trails, Inc. when attending club functions. Attire should be neutral in regard to political, religious, and social beliefs.
- C. Members will abide by the rules and regulations of any business establishment in which a Slopes & Trails, Inc. function is taking place.
- D. Safe behavior is the rule; do not endanger yourself or others.
- E. Smoking is not allowed at Slopes events.
- F. Excessive consumption of alcohol or any consumption of mood-altering drugs will result in being asked to leave, regardless of the time or place. A taxi will be called if needed and billed to the offending participants.
- G. All dues, fees, charges for Slopes events and activities are charged on an individual basis.
- H. Costs for damage incurred by any participant will be billed to that participant.

II. TRIP/EVENT POLICIES

- A. Members and their guests may attend trips/events, with members having sign-up priority. Sign-ups will be in the order of reservations received.
- B. Those who choose to participate in a trip or activity must understand that funds are often committed for the activity to take place and may not be refunded to us by the vendor. Deposits made by members will not be refunded.
- C. The place that a member or guest has reserved cannot be sold to another member or guest without the approval of the host/hostess due to possible room assignments or other conflicts about the trip/event.
- D. Some activities have inherent risks. If the risk is unclear, check with the event leader to clarify. Safety is the responsibility of each member.
- E. Participants are expected to be civil, courteous, and considerate of all other trip/event participants at all times.
- F. All payments must be made to the Club by the established deadlines.
- G. It is the member's responsibility to inform the host/hostess if they have a handicap that would prevent them from safely participating in an activity.
- H. Neither animals nor children under the age of 21 years are allowed at club functions unless published in advance.
- I. Members who volunteer to be carpool drivers must have a valid driver's license and appropriate automobile insurance. Such drivers must abide by all vehicular and state traffic laws.
